


IT'S THE DRAWING'S MOST BASIC AND SIMPLE ELEMENT.

The line


DEFINED AS A SET OF SUCCESSIVE POINTS THAT ORIGINATE A STROKE. LINES CAN BE STRAIGHT, CURVED, HORIZONTAL, VERTICAL, ZIGZAG AND OTHERS.



Texture




